

CROWDFUNDING

Crowdfunding is an approach allowing fundraisers to raise capital from a large number of people who contribute relatively small amounts via online platforms. This can be in the form of donations, loans, or equity financing, among others.

CASE STUDY 1: THE OCEAN CLEANUP

With the support of over **38,000 funders** from 160 countries, over **2 million USD** was raised in 100 days. The money raised helped The Ocean Cleanup initiate the engineering process as well as a series of expeditions. The collected oceanographic data is used by our engineers when designing the cleanup system.
